Within Inhambane province 33,172 homes were completely destroyed, while another 72,294 homes were partially destroyed



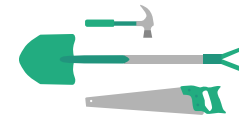
112,500 families affected

112,513 families were affected by the cyclones widespread damage. 7,652 were identified as "most vulnerable"

MOZAMBIQUE CYCLONE DINEO

On February 15 2017 Cyclone Dineo made landfall on the southern coast of Mozambique. Wind speeds reached 160km/hr causing widespread damage - homes, schools, municipal buildings all sustained damage, as well as agricultural land. ShelterBox response teams worked alongside Cruz Vermelha de Mozambique and community volunteers to identify the most vulnerable families in need of ShelterBox aid.
