When missiles and mortars leave cities in ruins, when troops storm villages, when families fear for their lives we believe that shelter can cut through the chaos

Shelter is more than a roof. It is protection from the cold, the rain, the sun, dangerous animals, disease. It is the foundation for life, for family, for community.

Right now, ShelterBox is providing aid to families with houses left in tatters by bombs and fighting. We' re helping families caught in some of the world's most extreme conflict zones, including the Syrian conflict and the Lake Chad Basin, and in some of the world's largest refugee camps like Cox's Bazar in Bangladesh.

Our work keeps families and communities together, increasing feelings of stability and togetherness during a time of unprecedented global conflict and displacement. We can't give back what was lost, but we can provide the tools for families and communities to start their own recovery.

ShelterBox provides tents, tarps, and other vital tools to rebuild a home. Solar lights so children can see their parents in the dark night. Blankets to keep warm; mosquito nets and water filters to protect from disease; cooking pots to provide meals.

Our work is based on collaboration and a shared vision.

ShelterBox is Rotary International's project partner in disaster relief. We also work with many global humanitarian aid agencies, including UNHCR, Red Cross, Amnesty International, UNICEF, and Médecins Sans Frontières.
