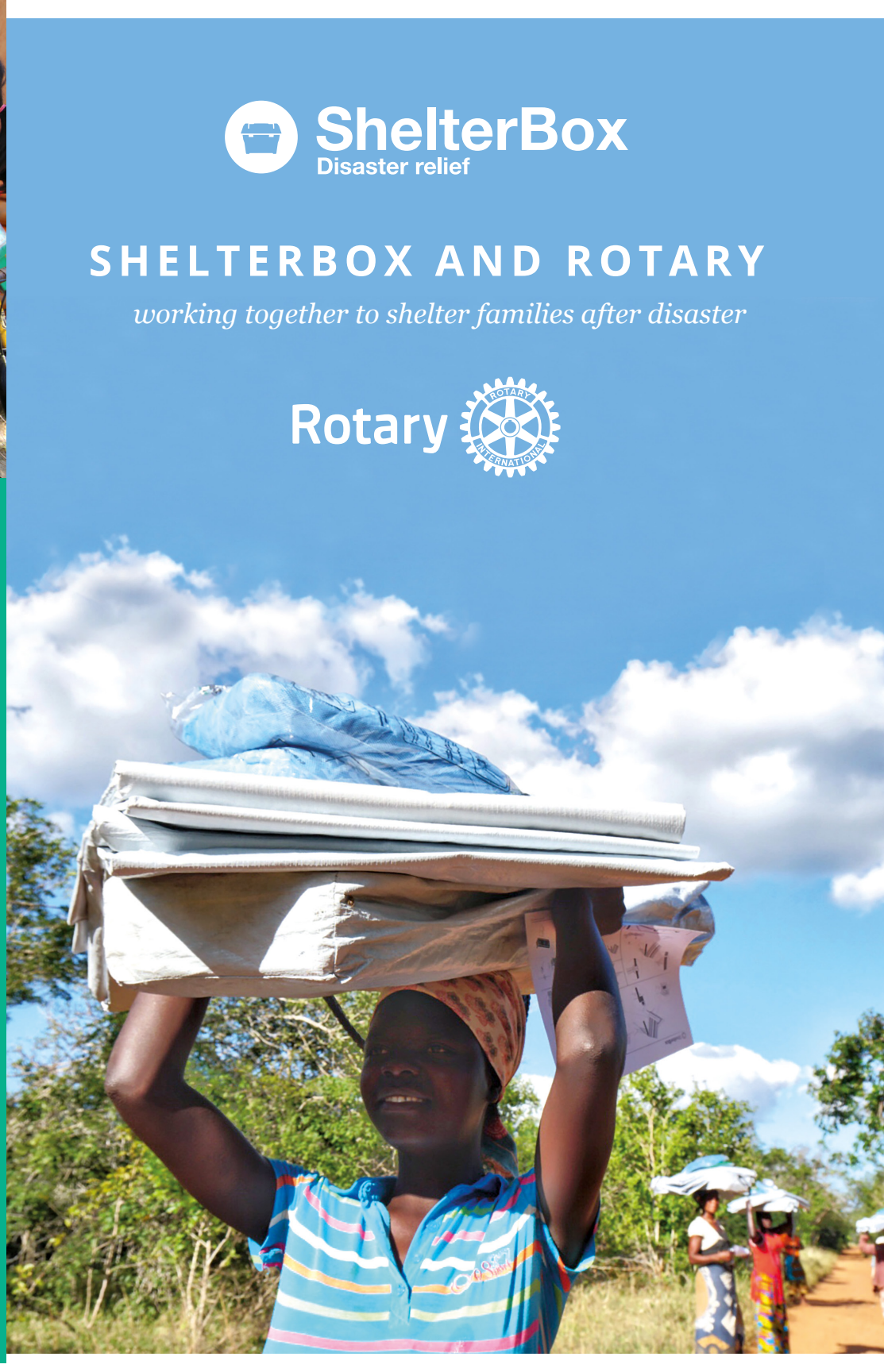

ShelterBox, is an international disaster relief organization that hand-delivers emergency shelter and the tools families need to self-recover after natural disasters and conflict around the world.

On average, only 1 in 5 families receive the emergency shelter they needed following a disaster. Not all disasters make the news, but all of them devastate people's lives.

Recovery starts with shelter. Having somewhere dry and warm to sleep, to prepare meals and be with your family, is vital for starting the long process of recovery.

Every disaster and community is different. This is why we have a flexible approach. We listen and learn from the communities we work alongside to provide them with the right tools to self-recover.



SHELTERBOX AND ROTARY IN ACTION



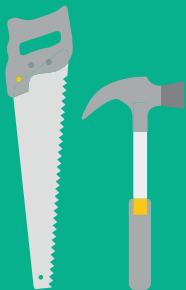

Following Tropical Storm Usman ShelterBox deployed teams to support families who had lost their homes. On arrival, the team met with a local Rotarian who was well prepared, he set up meetings with Rotary clubs in the worst affected areas.

In just over one-month, ShelterBox with support from Catarman and Calbayog Rotary Clubs, completed distributions of ShelterKits and provided training to over 2,000 families
